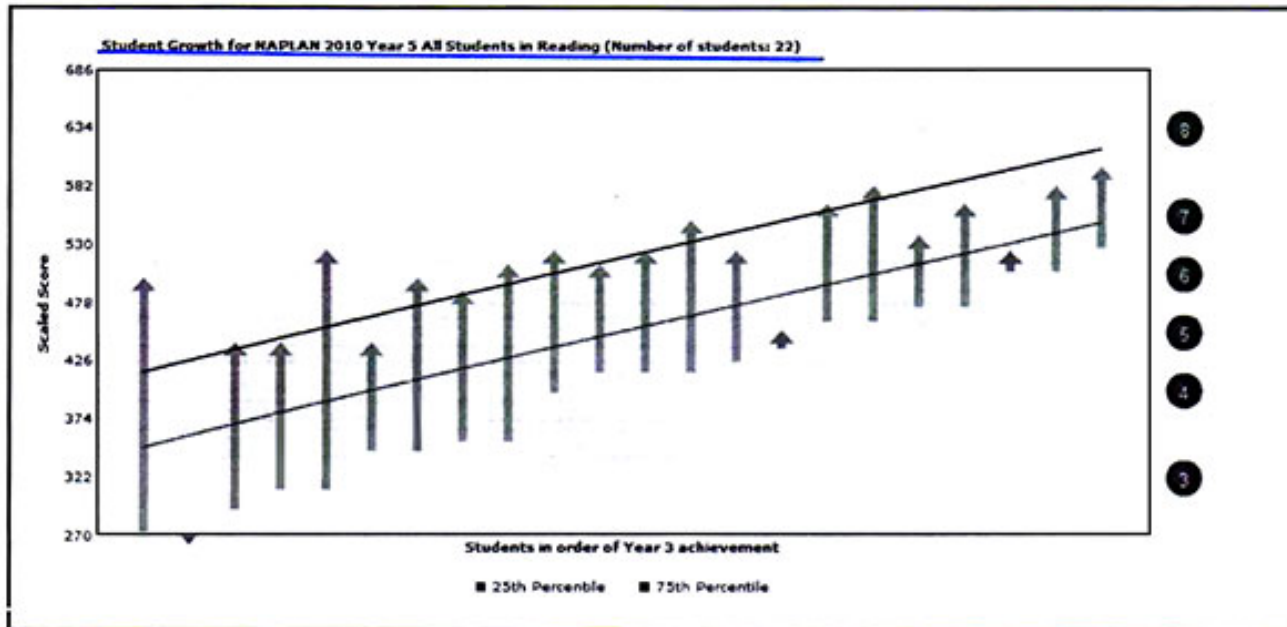
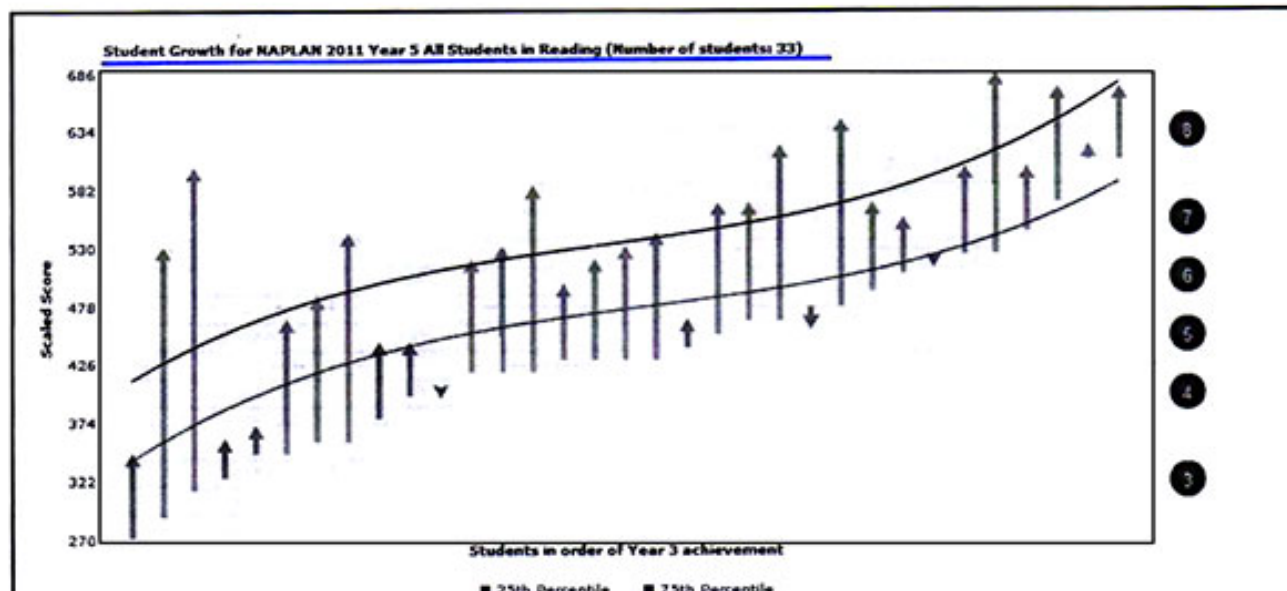

Student Growth for the Test Aspect of Reading



Annotation to Focus area 5.4

As NAPLAN coordinator I accessed SMART data results and shared findings with the teaching team. I worked with colleagues to analyse results and identified that the data supported the cooperative reading program as a successful program for improving students' reading. In 2011, the year 5 cohort performed above State and regional benchmarks with an average growth of 98.5. Data from my class confirms students at all ability levels experienced improvement, with an average growth of 110 in 2008 and 99 in 2011. This informs decision making and future planning for the cooperative reading program and due to its success with year 5 and 6 I will assist with implementation of the program across the school. Data also allows exploration of each student's results to target areas of specific learning difficulties and develop strategies to address group and individual student learning needs, such as modified activities and re-evaluation of reading groups.

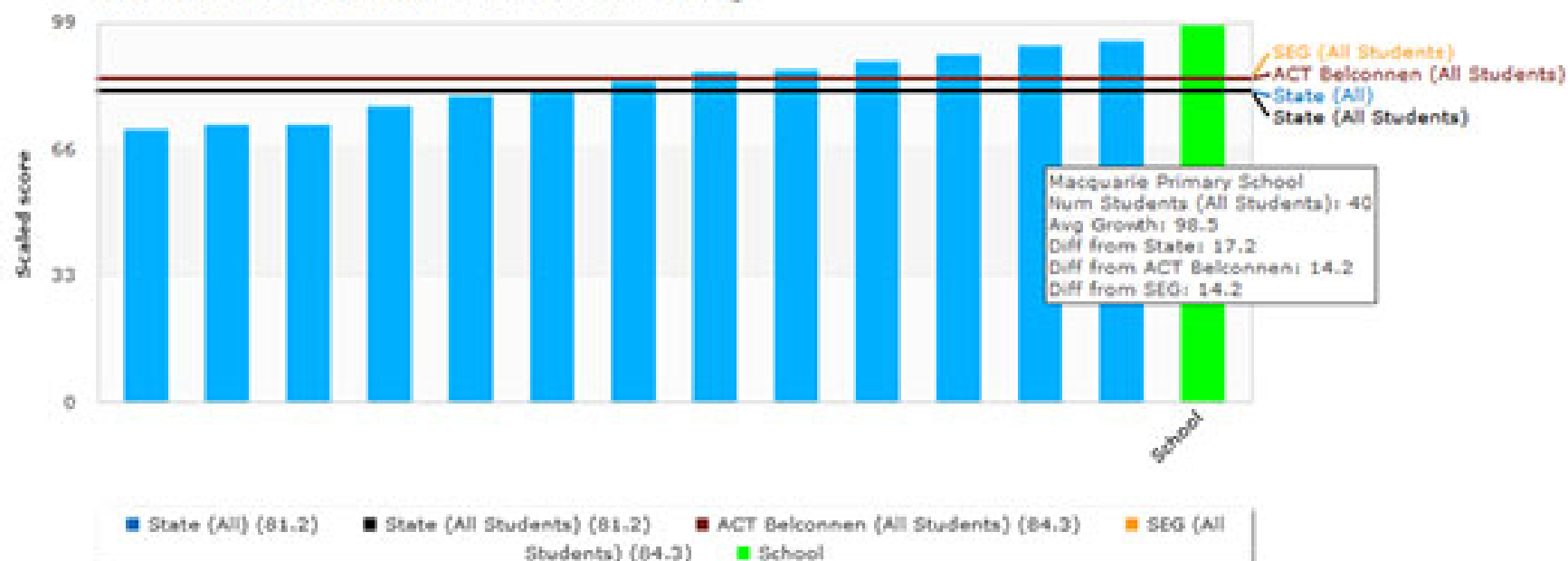
